Bacon will be served only once. This is a dine-in experience and takeout orders will be not allowed. The price per ticket is \$7. The breakdown of the ticket price: Applebee's keeps \$3 and AAWCC keeps \$4. We aren't required to pay for unsold tickets. We are not allowed to sell tickets on campus to students. We can sell tickets within our department. Do not sell tickets to students because of club guidelines at STC. It is imperative that during the event, we accept only the tickets issued (purple tickets). Last year, there was another Pancake Breakfast taking place that same day and participants from that event joined our event with a different color of tickets. Proceeds from the other event unfortunately, did not go to the AAWCC. The only tickets that will be accepted on February 11th will be the purple tickets. Those who volunteer to be a greeter and/or server will need to pay close attention that participants have the correct color of ticket.
